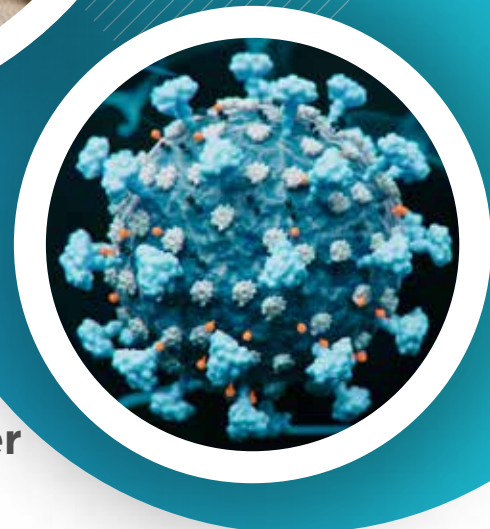

Antibody-Drug Conjugates in Cervical Cancer

ADCs deliver potent drugs directly to cancer cells, improving efficacy while minimizing systemic toxicity.

- ✓ **Example Agent:** Tisotumab vedotin (Tivdak).
- ✓ **Mechanism:** Monoclonal antibody delivers cytotoxin to tumor-expressed target.
- ✓ **Clinical Impact:** Improved response rates in recurrent/metastatic disease.
- ✓ **Fast Action:** Review KCMS ADC monitoring guide for managing ocular and nerve effects.
